The charity aims to improve healthcare in rural Nepal by empowering impoverished students to serve as doctors, nurses and midwives in their isolated rural communities, through the provision of scholarships and health projects.

Over the past 13 years, *Doctors for Nepal* has enabled ten doctors, twelve nurses and a midwife to qualify and work in rural areas, and is currently supporting seven more students through their studies – as well as supporting the postgraduate education of previously qualified doctors. The charity's ongoing health projects and appeals help thousands of people in the most deprived areas of Nepal.
